The purpose for this correspondence is to remind students and parents of the expectations associated with student behavior while riding the bus. All students are expected to follow the rules for bus behavior outlined in the Student Code of Conduct. Students who do not comply will be held accountable for inappropriate behavior that endangers their safety and the safety of the driver and passengers on the bus.


Students must ride the route assigned by Transportation and must get on and off the bus at the stop assigned. Once seated, it is required that all students remain seated (in their assigned seats) and face forward at all times until they get off the bus. All talking should be at a minimal level. Throwing any object while on the bus or out of the window will not be tolerated, as this compromises everyone's safety.

Each of the occurrences mentioned above is a serious violation of the Student Code of Conduct and will be treated as such. These violations can result in consequences such as bus privileges being denied for one day or up to a full semester of school.

Your child's homeroom teacher has discussed this with each student and administration requests your partnership in conveying these expectations at home as well.
